

PERMANENT TIME AND PLACE COMMITTEE MEETING

Gary Sammons presented a bid for the 2012 and 2013 Conventions at Radisson of Livonia for \$82 and/or the Crowne Plaza at Detroit Metro Airport for \$82 per night. Both offer free parking.

Mike Williams moved to use the Lexington of Lansing for the 2011 Winter Meeting. No support.

Roger Webster moved to use the Holiday Inn Flint for the 2011 Winter Meeting. Support by Darwin Krieger pending a site visit. Room rate of \$70 will only be held for 2 weeks. Motion carried.

Darwin Krieger moved to award the 2012 Convention to the Radisson of Kalamazoo. Supported by John Skinner. Motion carried.
