BEST POST WEBSITE DEPARTMENT OF MICHIGAN T.A.L.

AWARDED ANNUALLY AT STATE CONVENTION

To recognize the State Winner of the Post selected as having the most outstanding website in The Department of Michigan The American Legion.

Criteria:

1. The web pages must not be part of a personal home page.
2. Web pages must be dedicated to the 4 pillars of The American Legion (1. Veterans 2. Children & Youth 3. Patriotism and 4. National Security) as well as to the post and post business.
3. There must be a minimum of (5) pages.
4. The Web site must have a Post Officers page.
5. There must be a statement of purpose/mission statement.
6. There must be recent post projects with a minimum of (2) listed.
7. There must be (2) or more links to community Web Sites.
8. There must be a link to Department of Michigan Web site and all links must work.

Eligibility:

1. Post must have a working link and be listed in the *Post Communication Network.
2. Post webmaster, Post email address and WWW address must be listed in DMWSPCN (Dept. of Mich. Web Site Post Communication Network).

Judging Procedure

1. The site winner will be selected from the 5 Zone website winners.
2. Judging will be done by the Public Relations Committee Chairman and the Department Public Relations Director
3. Sites will be judged on:
 - a. Design and layout (does it flow, will I go inside?)
 - b. Originality (creativity)
 - c. Functionality (easy and clean navigation)
 - d. Appropriate use of JavaScript, applets, graphics, Flash, audio, video, etc.
 - e. Does site present a positive image and effectiveness of communication?
 - f. Content (is engaging, presents good public image for Legion, being updated appropriately)
 - g. Good links (no or limited broken links, missing pictures or graphics)
 - h. Contact information (post officers, webmaster, post email address, post location, post phone #)
 - i. Bandwidth usage (speed that pages load)
 - j. Overall look and feel of site.

Important Dates

1. All competing sites must submit their sites to the District and Zone Commanders for judging by May 1, of each year.
2. All zone winners must have their sites submitted to Department for judging by May 15 of each year.
3. Winner will be announced and award presented at State Convention.

** Post Communication Network: Network of Michigan Legion Posts that have websites and email addresses. The communication networks will be used to provide faster communication between posts and department, enable getting important information out to webmasters to share with their post members and enable webmasters on the network to share ideas, exchange skills and keep Michigan Legion Posts ahead of the WWW information technology learning curve.
