20 Glenn Ainslie and supported by Mr. Lyle Shanks to
21 be Vice commander. Mr. Lyle Shanks was nominated
22 as Secretary by Mr. Glenn Ainslie and supported by
23 Mr. Leonard Pierce. Motion carried.

24 Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Glenn
25 Ainslie and supported by Mr. Lyle Shanks that the
26 minutes of the Spring Meeting of the Department

1 Michigan Leadership Committee be approved. Motion
2 carried.

3 Old Business: Minutes of discussion

6 New Business: Mr. Glenn Ainslie made a

22 offices.

24 certificate and possibly a pin for the attendance
25 and completion of said Leadership class will be
26 presented. Mr. Leonard Pierce stated that this

1 would probably be a good incentive, and also stated
2 for the following year, perhaps, the class might be
3 held at the Joe Louis Post 375.

4 Mr. Charles Shackelford stated notices
5 would have to be sent to Posts, Districts, Michigan
6 Legionnaire and the Department Adjutant's Keeping
7 in Touch.

8 Mr. Alex Germany mentioned levels of
9 autonomy from Post to Department.
