Saluting Michigan Women Veterans

WOMEN IN THE MILITARY



Since the beginning of time women have served in all conflicts and wars in one capacity or another, always as a volunteer force. Women have gone from 'freeing a man to fight' to now being in the thick of battle.

In Michigan there are more than 45,000 women Veterans. For years women have been in the background of the veteran front. In keeping with this year's National Women's History Month theme of "Writing Women Back Into History", it's time for women Veterans to take their place front and center beside their brothers-in-arms.

The Women Marines Association MI-2 Motor City Chapter, together with the Northwest Detachment 162 of the Marine Corps League, the Michigan Women's Historical Center and Hall of Fame, along with the Western Wayne Oakland Association of Realtors and Star AMC Theaters are proud to come together to bring you the new history of our women in military service.

The film being shown, "*Lioness: There for the Action. Missing from History*", tells the story of a group of female Army support soldiers who were part of the first program in American history to send women into direct ground combat. Without the same training as their male counterparts but with a commitment to serve as needed, these young women fought in some of the bloodiest counterinsurgency battles of the Iraq war and returned home as part of this country's first generation of female combat veterans. *Lioness* makes public, for the first time, their hidden history.

Told through intimate accounts, journal excerpts, archival footage, as well as interviews with military commanders, the film follows five Lioness women who served together for a year in Iraq. With captivating detail, this probing documentary reveals the unexpected consequences that began by using these Army women to defuse tensions with local civilians, but resulted in their fighting alongside Marine combat units in the streets of Ramadi. Together the women's candid narratives describing their experiences in Iraq and scenes from their lives back home form a portrait of the emotional and psychological effects of war from a female point of view.
