Mr. McVeigh reported on the 5th district Tabs for Tots program and what they have done for this past year.

Chairman Geiger stated, if your district is awarded money for Tabs for Tots, the district commander has 45 days to contact Department to claim this money. If money is not claimed within that time period it will be passed on to the next district. To avoid this from happening, districts should have a project picked out ahead of time.

Consolidated Post Reports were 7 reports short of 50% for department. Some reports were not filled out properly and had to be disqualified from receiving an

award. CPR's will be discussed at fall conference at Boyne Highlands, Harbor Springs, MI on Sept. 14 & 15.

Temporary Financial Assistance has given \$2750.00 to be divided between 4 families. There were 6 requests denied.
