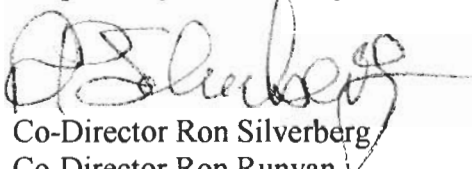
Past Department Commander Jerry Lynch asked about a list of Post Boy's State Chairman for the Posts in the Upper Peninsula.
