General Guy M. Wilson was born in Genesee County, Michigan on November 29, 1876. He graduated from Flint High School in 1893 and entered the University of Michigan where he graduated with a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1896. In 1898 he enlisted in the Spanish American War and at the close of the conflict he enlisted in the Michigan National Guard where he quickly ascended to the rank of General. The Guy M. Wilson Scholarship was created in 1938 to honor and preserve the memory of a great soldier and gentleman who served as the Michigan American Legion's second State Commander in 1920-21.

INSTRUCTIONS: This scholarship is **only** available to Michigan residents who are current Seniors in high school and are a son, daughter, grandchild or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to attend any Michigan accredited college, university, or trade school in the Fall of 2019. Selection is based on a student's G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals and intentions. Submit this scholarship form along with requested information to the American Legion Department of Michigan by the **deadline date of January 14, 2019 (not postmarked by)**.
